RENEWAL OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES AND ANTI-SUBSIDIES DUTIES AGAINST IMPORTS OF INDIAN DUCTILE IRON PIPES

On June 15th, 2022, the European Commission renewed the anti-dumping duties and anti-subsidies duties against imports of Indian ductile iron pipes.

In March 2016, the European Commission imposed anti-dumping duties and anti-subsidies duties against these very same imports; these duties expiring in March 2021 and noting the continuation of practices contrary to European Union regulations on protection against dumped imports and against subsidized imports from countries not members of the European Union. Saint-Gobain PAM, Saint-Gobain PAM España and Saint-Gobain PAM Deutschland lodged on December 21st, 2020 a request for expiry review.

Upon receipt of these requests, the European Commission investigated and thus concluded that imports of Indian ductile iron pipes are still dumped and subsidized and causing a material injury to the Union Industry. The European Commission also concluded that the injury is likely to continue and deteriorate should the duties be allowed to lapse.

Consequently, anti-dumping duties and anti-subsidies duties imposed in 2016 are maintained until June 2027.

Overall Legal Background

Anti-dumping and countervailing measures (anti-subsidies) aim to restore fair competition between products imported from third countries and products manufactured in the European Union. The purpose is not to punish third-party imports or artificially increase the cost of imported products, but to fight against practices considered unfair by the World Trade Organization. For this reason, these measures only apply against imports from the countries from which the practices considered unfair originate.
